# THE LOCATION



# BENALMADENA, MALAGA

Geographically situated right in the centre of the Costa del Sol, (Malaga) Benalmadena's municipal area stretches from the foothills of the Sierra de Mijas to the sea, where it occupies a short coastal strip.

### Three districts form the town:

Benalmádena Pueblo (the old town) evokes calmness with its picturesque urban landscape of narrow streets and plazas, while Benalmádena Costa brings a holiday feel with a long coastline divided into 15 beaches. Arroyo de la Miel, a vibrant community, is a pretty locality where a large number of leisure attractions of this destination are concentrated.



# THE BEACHES



### THE CLIMATE

Benalmadena enjoys a subtropical Mediterranean climate, with hot summers and warm winters. Cooling breezes from the sea make the summer heat manageable and temperatures are an average of 30 °C in summer and 17 °C in winter.



## THE SCHOOL FACILITIES







Maravillas programas internacionales is located on the upper floor of a modern building situated in the city centre (Arroyo de la Miel) within walking distance from the local train station and from the beaches.

**24 modern classrooms** equipped with the latest technology and air conditioning, a students room with a wide range of books available, a large multi-purpose room for conferences, cinema or meetings, a 600 mq sunshade terrace, with a cafeteria serving breakfast and lunches. Free WIFI in all premises and wheelchair access for students with disabilities.



The "family" feeling is still the school's most important asset. Colegio Maravillas has approximately 60 students at one time, during the year and more than 200 students per week in the summer season, from Europe, Asia and North America.

# THE COURSE

The course consists of 15 hours (60 minutes) taught in small groups of 15 students maximum. On the first day all students take a Language Assessment test which allows us to place the participant in the appropriate classes. All levels accepted.

The lessons focus on effective communication and improving speaking ability. Interactive lessons taught by dynamic native teachers - fully qualified in teaching spanish as a foreign language- combined with a range of social and cultural activities ensure that students have the opportunity to use the language learned in class in real-life situation.

At the end of the course, every student receives a full report on his work and progress, as well as a Course Completion Certificate.




















### EXTRA SPORT OPTION

### SAILING LESSONS & WATER SPORTS



Students enrolled in this course will have three hours of sailing lessons in the afternoons twice per week. The sailing lessons take place with professional instructors in the safe environment of PUERTO MARINA. All equipment is provided by the sailing school, including wetsuits and buoyancy aids. Students are required to wear buoyancy aids at all times when on the water. If the weather is too windy or there is too little wind, alternative water sports activities will be arranged, or the sessions will be postponed and rescheduled for another day. No prior sailing experience is necessary. This course is not recommended for experienced sailors.



# SPRING BREAK

This is a course designed for young students from 13 to 17 years who wish to attend a Spanish language course during their spring and half term holidays and is available to individual clients and small groups. It has a similar structure to our popular Summer Course, combining Spanish lessons with social activities, sports, excursions and visits.

# HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION



We understand that for many students it is the first time they live this experience and we want it to be unforgettable. At the end or your stay, you will have really good memories, friends for life, and a second home in Spain!

The accommodation is always provided with local **host-families**, previously inspected, in double rooms (sharing with another student of similar age and different nationality) on a full board basis. On weekdays, the family will take care of breakfast and dinner, while lunches will be served at the school lunch Hall. During weekends, they will receive a picnic lunch to take to the excursion (Saturdays) or they will eat at home with the family (Sundays).

We take special care in choosing families for our youngest students and we apply strict selection criterias with inspections that are renewed every year.

The characteristics of each family are different, there may be young families with small children, separated ladies or retired couples, with or without pets. They can live in large houses or in smaller apartments near the city center or the beach.

### ALLERGIES

Students suffering from a special allergy are only accepted if they are capable of managing their allergy independently. We accept no responsibility with regards to allergic reactions. It is mandatory that we are informed about all student's allergies when enrolling: we need this information to place your student with the correct host family.

**Dietary supplement:** coeliac, lactose free, gluten free, vegan: 15€/week

### **INSURANCE**

Students are advised to take out personal insurance to cover them against any cause related to the COVID19, cancellation or unexpected termination of the course, quarantine and other medical costs.





### TRANSFER FROM / TO MALAGA AIRPORT

The transfer to the airport is included in the course fees.

Flight details should be sent to our secretary office no later than 2 weeks before the arrival date and should include flight number, airline, airport of departure, and time of arrival to Málaga. **Supplement of 25 euros, in case of night arrivals/departures**, applying to transfer services to be organized AFTER 23:00 hours or BEFORE or at 07:00 a.m.

Our representative will wait in the Arrival Hall (just after customs) holding a sign bearing the student's name. Before being transferred to their host families, students may have to wait with our representative for up to 30 minutes in order to gather students arriving via other incoming flights.



### WELFARE AND SUPERVISION

We are most concerned about the safety and well-being of our young participants and, although our main objective is to offer an enjoyable language stay, we have set up some rules:

- **1)** Attendance to the Language course, afternoon and evening activities, as well as all visits and excursions is COMPULSORY.
- **2)** Any student who abuses alcohol or uses any other drug will be immediately expelled from the course with no refund of fees.
- **3)** Students must respect the curfew set by the school: a) Daytime: all students are authorized to go out unaccompanied until 7:30 p.m. b) Evening: students will only be authorized to go out unaccompanied with **parental permission**, and always respecting the school curfew: please ask for our "**permission form**" which must be signed and returned 2 weeks before your child's arrival to Spain.

Behaviour: any student who commits a criminal offence, exhibits anti-social behaviours or has poor attendance may be expelled.

**UM SERVICE:** Young children traveling without a parent or legal guardian are considered Unaccompanied Minors (UM). Most airlines offer a service to assist these children from their departure point to their final destination. If you book the UM service with your airline, there is an additional fee for the service of our representative who will pick up the child at the airport upon arrival or departure.

The supplements are: On arrival 15€ / On arrival and departure €35. Information about this service must be provided 2 weeks before the student's arrival at the latest.
